









Terms and conditions of the XTELA Program of Business Acceleration and Open Innovation



MARCH 2024

TECHNOLOGY AND SCIENCE PARK OF CANTABRIA PCTCAN

















1. INTRODUCTION

The Management Company of the Scientific and Technological Park of Cantabria, SL (hereinafter SGPCTCAN), attached to the Department of Industry, Employment, Innovation and Commerce of the Government of Cantabria, is an industrial policy tool aimed at promoting development and social well-being . –economic of the Autonomous Community.

SGPCTCAN by virtue of the Business Acceleration Framework Program and the Government Council Agreements of May 9, 2019, April 7, 2022 and March 21, 2024 participates in the management of the XTELA Business Acceleration and Open Innovation Program (in the Program forward).

SGPCTCAN launches the XTELA Program, which has a marked strategic nature and aims to achieve the objectives of quality and innovation in the science-technology-business ecosystem of the region. In addition, it aims to achieve the innovative development of new projects that improve the socioeconomic environment of the region.

The Innovation Strategy of Cantabria 2016-2030 promoted by the Ministry of Innovation, Employment, Tourism and Commerce, already in its axis 4 "Innovative Industrial Entrepreneurship and Exploitation of

















results" considered among its key actions the creation of a regional innovative business accelerator, equipped with a program and a strategy. Likewise, the Cantabria Intelligent Specialization Strategy 2021-2027 (RIS 3 CANTABRIA) includes in two of its fundamental challenges (Innovative Cantabria and Competitive and Innovative Cantabria) lines of action related to the acceleration of regional business and open innovation.

2. GOALS

This program involves the implementation of a set of actions so that companies in the region belonging to the priority ecosystems of Cantabria (Industry 4.0, Blue Economy and Offshore Industry, Bioeconomy and Agri-Food Sector, Health and Wellbeing and Cultural Industry and Sustainable Tourism) work with Startup teams through collaboration agreements to implement solutions for real Industry 4.0 and energy sustainability projects. A win-win approach that leverages the flexibility and drive of young startups with the experience and resources of established companies. This is an international program aimed at innovative Startups from anywhere in the world that propose innovative solutions in the field of Industry 4.0 and energy sustainability.

















The acceleration program aims to achieve the following objectives:

- Growth: Accelerate the growth of Startups with the collaboration of driving companies.
- Digital Transformation: Promote the Digital Transformation of companies
- Energy sustainability: Promote the transformation towards more sustainable production models.
- Collaboration: Stimulate public-private collaboration.
- Promote Industry 4.0 and sustainability among the priority ecosystems of Cantabria.
- Talent: Promote local talent and attract national and international talent.

3. **DEFINITIONS**

Startup: Newly created company with a scalable business model and a high technological component that has great growth possibilities.

















Corporates: Organization regardless of its legal form (society, mutual fund, foundation, etc.) with a work center in Cantabria belonging to the industry, health or biotechnology sector.

Challenge: A problem, opportunity and/or challenge posed by companies to find new innovative solutions and make them a reality (innovate and undertake) with new ways of working.

Project: set of activities to be carried out to respond to the proposed challenge. The project may include the design, development, and/or improvement of a product, service and/or process.

Demo Day: event to present the final results of the projects.

4. PROGRAM DEFINITION

The Program will act as a bridge between innovation and the business environment, offering a new system so that large companies in Cantabria and key sectors can establish new ways of working. At the same time it offers a framework where new ideas can be scaled and supported. The Program will offer access to innovative systems in early stages, in a cheaper, faster and more flexible way than internally

















developed R&D, creating numerous advantages for companies. Investing in acceleration systems creates economic benefits while at the same time enhancing the entrepreneurial spirit and business culture.

Likewise, support will be offered to Startups with mentoring work, physical spaces, specific knowledge and additional resources.

SPACES

PCTCAN makes the Xtela Tower available to the Program, a building intended for both the installation of companies and the carrying out of activities related to the Program. The Xtela Tower has 4 floors distributed in offices and offices, in addition to a floor with spaces oriented towards multifunctionality (function room, meeting room, office, etc.)

ACCESS TO END CUSTOMER

In case any of the projects of the selected Startups are of interest to you, the Corporates undertake to formalize a contract, at least during the course of the Program, for a minimum amount of €15,000, which will be used for the development of the project, product and/or service of the Startup.

















TUTORING

The Startups will have a responsible person, who will be in charge of monitoring the projects, making the calls for the different phases and controlling the participation of the Startups in the activities.

TRAINING

The Program will have experts in different areas of knowledge who will provide training to the Startups in business skills with the aim of offering training to the teams, in addition to adding value to the Startups' business model.

MENTORING

The Startups will have mentoring through people who have solid business experience whose job will be to instruct, accompany and advise the Startup on product and strategy, thus ensuring the success of the initiative.

NETWORKING

The Startups will participate in the meetings, conferences and events organized by the Program to develop their business model through the

















establishment of relationships, agreements, exchange of experiences and taking advantage of synergies between the projects.

CANTABRIA BUSINESS ECOSYSTEM

The Program will promote the generation of an ecosystem open to cooperation with the initiatives launched in PCTCAN, SODERCAN and the partners and collaborators of the Program for the development of new opportunities, promoting relationships with the rest of the companies in Cantabria, Universities, Institutes and Technological Centers, etc.

ACCESS TO CALLS

Companies participating in the Program will be able to request and access calls for aid under the complementary aid programs and plans at regional, national or European level that are launched to support acceleration and entrepreneurship projects.

5. STARTUPS REQUIREMENTS

Startups that meet the following requirements will be eligible:

- Startup less than 8 years old.
- High innovative and technological potential: with activity in

















industry 4.0: Factories of the future, robotization, digitalization, IoT , advanced manufacturing, automation, artificial intelligence, Big Data, satellite and radio frequency communication, industrial transition and decarbonization and energy sustainability.

- With a Minimum Viable Product/Service (distance to market <
 1 year)
- Be up to date with your tax and Social Security obligations.

6. CORPORATE REQUIREMENTS

- Be linked to one of the Innovation Ecosystems of the Intelligent Specialization Strategy 2021-2027 RIS3 (Industry 4.0, Blue Economy and Offshore Industry, Bioeconomy and Agri-Food Sector, Health and Wellbeing and Cultural Industry and Sustainable Tourism)
- Have a work center in Cantabria
- Have availability for dedication and involvement in the different activities contemplated in the program, among others, the following: presentation events, startup selection process, startup mentoring, Demo Day

















If any of the projects of the selected Startups are of interest,
 the company intends to formalize a contract, at least during
 the course of the Program, for an amount of at least €15,000
 that will be allocated to the development of the project. ,
 product and/or service of the Startup .

7. PHASES OF THE PROGRAM

Phase 1. Publication of challenges.

Corporates interested in participating in the program must detail their challenges in accordance with the model reflected in Annex I. These will be challenges related to Industry 4.0 and Energy Sustainability: Factories of the future, robotization, digitalization, IoT, advanced manufacturing, automation, artificial intelligence, Big Data, satellite and radio frequency communication, industrial transition and decarbonization.

The challenges will be published on www.xtela.net

Phase 2. Presentation of solutions

Startups interested in participating in one or more challenges (up to a maximum of 4) must complete the online participation form that appears at www.xtela.net/retos according to the model that appears

















in Annex II of this document. The form could be accompanied by as many documents as are considered necessary (up to a maximum of 15 MB) to complete your proposal.

The program is aimed at innovative, disruptive, scalable startups with high growth potential.

To formalize registration in the program, the complete registration document for the corresponding challenge must be sent through the website.

Phase 3. Admission of applications

To admit the applications and move on to the next phase, a minimum technical and resource solvency will be required for the Startups, which will be accredited as follows:

A) Promoter team: training, experience and skills related to the project to be developed.

To do this, the CV of at least one expert person with knowledge and/or experience in the area of specialization proposed in the solution will be requested.

















- **B) Business idea:** level of innovation and degree of maturity of the project to be developed.
- **C) Business Model:** adaptation and sizing of the resources necessary to launch the project, the potential and/or capacity for internationalization and its ability to access the market.
- **D) Degree of Acceleration:** scalability of the project, existing and expected competition and the size and projection of its growth in the market.

To do this, a descriptive report of the business model defined for the startup will be requested that contains, at least, points B, C and D above.

Phase 4. Pre-selection of applications

Once the previous phase is over, the proposed solutions will be transferred to the Corporates participants, who will be in charge of making a preselection of those projects that best adapt to the challenges posed.

















Phase 5. Pitch

The Startups selected by the companies will present their project to the companies with the aim of finding the strategic partner with which to develop their proposal and participate in the Program.

To this end, they will receive the necessary support and resources from the Program to carry out the presentation in the most effective way possible.

Phase 6. Matching

In this phase, the Corporates interested in any of the Startups' proposals must formalize a contract to carry out the project jointly for no less than 15,000 euros.

For each project, the Startups must sign the participation commitment that appears in the Annex. III. Additionally, Startups and Corporates must sign an agreement that formally regulates the relationship that will keep during the program, in the shape in that both parts estimate convenient and leaving established the conditions of bliss collaboration.

















Phase 7: Program Development

The Acceleration Program lasts approximately 6 months. During this time, mentoring, training activities, networking sessions, etc. will be held.

The participating Startups and companies will have accompaniment and support from specialized mentors.

Phase 8: Demo Day

At the end of the Program, a Demo Day will be held in which the Startups will make a presentation about the progress of their projects to the rest of the participants and potential investors and business partners.

8. OBLIGATIONS OF STARTUPS

The selected companies that are part of the Xtela Business

Acceleration and Open Innovation Program must:

 Attend program actions when they affect the completion of your project.

















- Provide the dedication required by specialized experts, to the extent considered appropriate for the correct completion of your project.
- Keep the SGPCTCAN technicians and the Department responsible for innovation informed of the evolution of the project.
- Provide two emails to send communications, in addition to responding to those communications that require it.

9. DOCUMENTATION TO BE SUBMITTED BY STARTUPS PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM

Prior to formalizing the agreement with the Corporates , the following documentation will be requested from the selected Startups:

- Constitution Deeds.
- Certificates of being up to date in the fulfillment of their obligations before the State Tax Administration Agency, the Cantabrian Tax Administration Agency and before the General Treasury of Social Security
- Responsible declaration signed by both (Startup and

















Corporate) accrediting formalization of the agreement for an amount of no less than €15,000.

10.ADVERTISING

All documentation and information of interest will be published on the Program website (www.xtela.net), on the SGPCTCAN portal and in any media deemed appropriate and will include the application form that applicants will have to submit to participate in the Acceleration Program, as well as the deadlines for submitting the projects.

11. CONFIDENTIALITY AND DATA PROTECTION

The tasks developed as a consequence of the execution of this program, as well as the documentation generated by them, will be understood at all times to be the exclusive property of the party that provides it, guaranteeing by SGPCTCAN the total confidentiality of the information, works and other activities carried out, of which only both parties will be aware.

SGPCTCAN undertakes to treat confidentially any data or information provided to it and will adopt the necessary measures to guarantee the confidentiality of said data and information, in

















accordance with the provisions of the RGPD and other applicable regulations.

Data or information that: (a) is in the public domain or that becomes public domain will not be considered confidential information; (b) were created, provided, discovered, developed or obtained by one party without using the confidential information of the other; (c) have been received from a third party not subject to an obligation of confidentiality with respect to the parties, as the case may be; and (d) must be disclosed by law.

If SGPCTCAN is interested in using the technical information outside the scope of the relationship stipulated in this program, it must request express written authorization from the other party, being responsible for the possible consequences that may arise from failure to comply with this obligation.

On the other hand, SGPCTCAN reserves the right to publicly disseminate the content of this line.

The participant authorizes SGPCTCAN to use the name and title of his or her project, without time limit, to be mentioned on the website

















or for any actions or events related in any way to SGPCTCAN, as well as for its reflection in historical files and media. of various kinds.

Likewise, the Trademarks, Trade Names and Logos owned by the beneficiaries or over which they hold a right of use may be used by SGPCTCAN in the promotion of its own products or services in the usual means and formats of communication and within the uses brand loyalists.

The personal data provided to us by interested parties will be processed by SGPCTCAN for the sole purpose of managing this program.

SGPCTCAN, as data controller, has designated a Data Protection Officer who can be contacted at <u>lopd pctcan @ grupoodercan.es</u>. This treatment is based on the consent of the applicant and the need to process and manage the program.

Since the personal data will be provided by the requesting company or entity, it is responsible for its veracity and for having obtained the corresponding consent to send the requested information.

Personal data will be kept throughout the processing of the file and subsequently for the time necessary to comply with the legal

















obligations to which SGPCTCAN is obliged. The data will not be communicated to third parties with the exception of those that are essential for the management of the requests, in which case the corresponding data processor contracts will be formalized.

Any statement to the contrary by the participant will imply his or her exclusion from the program and the SGPCTCAN will be released from compliance with the obligation contracted with said participant.
